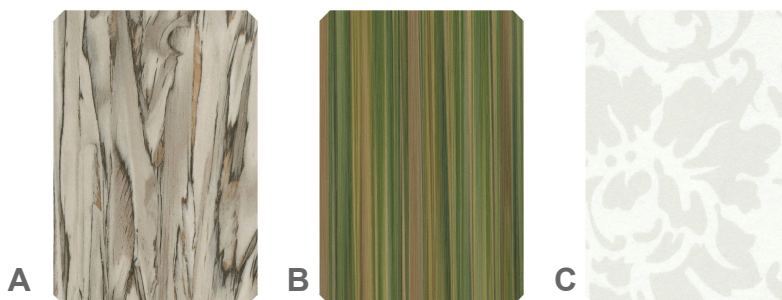

When we asked interior designer, Kelvin Murray from Altis Architecture, what inspired him to choose RUSTICA for the recently completed Nelson Bay RSL, this is what he had to say:

“Nelson Bay RSL was designed to fulfil the brief of creating a new look for the club that encapsulated the coastal location nestled along the foreshores of Nelson Bay that would appeal to the local residents as well as the seasonal influx of visitors to the area. We wanted to achieve this by inserting a mixed palette of materials and surfaces that created a ‘Coastal’ feel including timber, stone and warm textures.

With budget restraints, using real timber was out of the question, so alternatives were required leading us to specify ‘RUSTICA’ which was extensively used throughout for the joinery and cladding material. The finished product is outstanding with most visitors believing it is real timber”.
